CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year, Trinity College offers a limited number of scholarships in a specific window of opportunity. Applicants are selected on the basis of their application, interview and supporting documentation.

Academic Excellence Scholarships are awarded to selected students, based on evidence of previous academic achievement and capability. Applicants must demonstrate qualities compatible with the ethos of the College. Scholarships of up to 50% of tuition fees (consumable fees are still payable) are available.

Character Excellence Scholarships are awarded to selected well-rounded students who demonstrate qualities compatible with the ethos of the College and their contribution and/or ability in areas such as Christian mission or humanitarian work, overall pastoral influence of their peers and service to the community, such as helping in Chapel. Scholarships of up to 50% of tuition fees (consumable fees are still payable) are available.

Sporting Excellence Scholarships are awarded to students who achieve at a representative level, or above, in a sport supported by Trinity College Gladstone. Scholarships of up to 50% of tuition fees (consumable fees are still payable) are available.

Creative and Performing Art Excellence Scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate a God-given talent in either Art or the Performing Arts (such as Drama), based on a portfolio of work such as previous roles in musicals, choirs/ensembles or artworks. Scholarships of up to 50% of tuition fees (consumable fees are still payable) are available.

Requirements and conditions placed on Scholarship Holders

To maintain a scholarship students must:

- demonstrate high standards in relation to effort.
- demonstrate high standards of behaviour at all times.
- demonstrate a positive influence in the College community.
- demonstrate high standards in relation to attendance and uniform.

Academic Scholarship holders must:

- achieve high achievement standards in the end of semester reports.

Character Scholarship holders must:

- Demonstrate annually a commitment to the student culture of the school through both formal involvement in activities and informal interactions.

Sporting Scholarship holders must:

- be involved in the College sporting teams related to the scholarship.
- support the sporting events of the College.
- compete at representative levels each year in a school sport so that the scholarship may continue.

Creative and Performing Arts Scholarship holders must:

- be involved in the Arts through formal activities which the school facilitates. One example would be the painting of a school mural, or a role in a school musical.

Awarding of Scholarships

- All scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Principal.
- The conditions above are guidelines for the minimum expected standards to be considered for a scholarship offer.
- In order to maintain a scholarship, recipients must maintain minimum standards of behaviour, academic efforts, involvement in College life and achievement in their scholarship area.
- Subject to meeting the conditions to maintain a scholarship, it is expected that the scholarship will remain in place until the scheduled end date. Each scholarship awarded will have a normal end date, at which time the scholarship will cease. Families may choose to reapply for available scholarships in the 12 months prior to the cessation date.

The decision to award a scholarship and the level of assistance granted is entirely at the discretion of the Principal.

No correspondence will be entered into regarding such decisions.

Length of Scholarships

Scholarships at Trinity College run for 3 years from the commencement date, unless stipulated to be shorter in length prior to formal agreement.

Cancellation of Scholarships

A scholarship may be cancelled if:

- the recipient fails to maintain the high standards and expectations as set out above;
- the recipient is suspended or excluded from the College;
- payment of consumable fees/levies/etc. are not settled by end of each Term;
- the student leaves the College.
