DUE DATE DISCOUNTS

Early Payment Discount - Applied to Annual Upfront Payments Only

10% of Tuition fees (excluding levies) if the annual fee is paid before 12th February 2020.

Direct Debit Discount - Applied to Direct Debit Authorities Only.

5% of Tuition fees (excluding levies) if the agreement has been presented to the school office and first payment scheduled prior to the 12th February 2020.



College Fees

College Fees are comprised of Tuition Fees and Non-Tuition Levies. These levies contribute to costs such as compulsory camps, incursions, excursions, swimming lessons and student accident insurance.

In addition to this, the College provides *optional* access to clubs and after school activities. While some of these activities are at no-cost, some of the activities are charged separately e.g. Music tutoring, Academic Competitions. The fees include planned activities but occasionally an unplanned opportunity may exist. Parents will be notified of these opportunities as they arise and invoiced separately as appropriate. We attempt to keep non-tuition levies 'inclusive', to allow for better budgeting and planning.

Payment

The College fee structure relies on the prompt payment of fees. The fees are invoiced in full prior to the commencement of Term 1.

Our payment options are flexible and can be nominated on a weekly, fortnightly, monthly or term basis.

We accept payments by Bpay, Direct debit, Credit card, Cash and EFTPOS;

Notification of Fee Payments are made by completing the attached forms. The plan must be agreed to prior to the commencement of the school year. Any default on a payment will result in all fees being due immediately.

Financial Rebates

The College provides relief to families through the Income Assessed Rebate Application process. We offer a tiered rebate system to ensure there is an equitable approach to the rebates offered. All families are eligible to apply for a rebate on Tuition Fees. Applications will be assessed based on thresholds set by the College Board.

Short Term Concessions will be considered upon application by the Principal and Business Manager where a demonstrated need exists due to financial circumstances.

Please contact the Administration team for a Rebate Application. Appropriate evidence must be provided along with the rebate application form.

Scholarships

Scholarships commence in May at the Twilight Showcase event. Trinity College offers Academic, Creative & Performing Arts, Character and Sporting Scholarships. All Scholarships are open to new and existing families.

Textbook Scheme

The College provides students with all required textbooks through the State Government Textbook Scheme. Textbooks and library books not returned by the required date will incur the full price of the replacement charged to the Parent fee account. Refund of replacement charges on subsequently returned textbooks and library books will not be considered unless books are returned in good condition.



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BUS FARES

Bus applications are available from the office. Depending on student requirements there are three passes available. Please see the Bus Application for further information.

Annual Pass: \$1,040.00 per student

The Annual Pass is invoiced at the start of the year and can be incorporated into a regular payment plan. The Annual Pass only requires parents to complete the Bus Applications once.

Term Pass: \$260.00 per student

Term Bus Passes are invoiced once per term. A Bus Application will be required each Term to confirm arrangement. Payments must be received by the due date, after which a \$20 late fee will be incurred. Non-payment of the Bus Fare will result in your Pass being cancelled.

Flexi Pass (10 trips): \$40.00

A Flexi-pass can be used for irregular or low booking requirements. A Flexi-pass must be purchased before use. Regular bookings are arranged in line with standard process. Irregular bookings must be confirmed with the Bus Scheduler prior to use. Emergency booking requests must be received by 2.30pm and are subject to seat availability.

BUILDING FUND

Application Fee: \$100 per student non-refundable fee payable upon submission of Application Forms.

Bond: Bonds are payable for the first three children. The bond will be refunded when the child leaves the College as long as appropriate notice has been given, all resources have been returned and fees are up to date.

First child: \$250

Notification of Departure

One term's notice must be given in writing to the College prior to the removal of a student from the College. If the required notice is not received, one term's all-inclusive fees will be payable in lieu of notice.
