FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Looking forward to Term 4
Congratulations! We have made it to the end of a very busy Term 3, in what has been a very unusual year.

We will commence Term 4 on Tuesday, 6 October 2020.

In Term 4:

- Our Year 12 cohort will only be returning to us for three weeks of normal school before they sit the very first External Examination block of exams.

These exams will be added to their other assessment tasks in Year 12 to calculate their score used for entry to university, called an ATAR.

- Our Year 11 students will be finishing off their Year 11 coursework in the first few weeks of Term 4, then they will commence their Year 12 learning. This enables them to maximise their Year 12 learning time before they too need to sit their External Examinations.

- On Friday 23 October, the school will be putting on a Colourful Fun Run for all

students. Our Cross-Country carnivals were cancelled due to COVID-19 – and this event will be a fun way to celebrate running together in a fun way.

- Our Kindergarten will commence their 'Step into Prep' transition program as they get ready for 'big school', including beginning to attend our assemblies. It is exciting to note that Prep and Year 1 for 2021 are now full.

Lastly, while we will still have to keep a number of restrictions in place around safe practices in Term 4 (For example, we are currently trying to navigate these restrictions for our Prep-Year 3 swimming carnival, and our Year 12 Formal), we are committed to do what we can for the learning of our students and the strengthening of our community.
