We remain firmly committed to an excellent Rugby Union program, which has grown from one team in 2018 to three teams in 2020, including a fantastic girls team. The recent upgrade of our College oval to have official Rugby Union goal posts and be the correct width for a Trinity College Rugby home field is testament to our commitment to a sport our students can excel in.

At Trinity College, we desire to provide students access to a great suite of sports. In 2019, we launched a Mountain Biking program, which has continued to be successful despite no official competition in 2020.
